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Focus groups

The focus group highlighted a practical need in schools.

Teachers and educators are interested in tools that can support everyday tasks such as simplifying texts, adapting materials, preparing activities, or presenting content in different ways for learners with different needs.

In inclusive classrooms, this kind of support can make daily work easier and help teachers respond more quickly to different situations.

At the same time, they are looking for real examples, clear guidance, and concrete ideas they can use in class.

They also want to better understand the limits of AI tools and which parts of the educational work still require the teacher's judgement and responsibility.

About the project

ASK – AI Supported Knowledge for Accessibility is an Erasmus+ project that helps teachers and educators use ChatGPT in a more inclusive way, especially with students with disabilities and learning difficulties.

What we have done so far

The partners held the first project meeting and carried out the first focus group with teachers and educators in Italy (Pianezza) & Latvia (Valmiera)

What comes next

The next phase will build on this first feedback. The partnership will now:

- collect and test concrete uses of ChatGPT in school contexts
- develop a practical guide for inclusive teaching
- organise training activities built on real classroom needs, not theory alone
