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From discussion to practical work

After the first project discussions, the next step was to understand **which prompts were actually worth keeping**.

The work focused on **everyday school tasks**: *simplifying texts, adapting instructions, supporting comprehension, writing, communication, and assessment*. From there, the project built a first set of **50 draft prompts**.

WHAT HAPPENED NEXT

Those prompts were not left on paper. They were reviewed, tested, and rewritten through **workshop activities based on real teaching situations**. This helped cut what was too vague and keep what could actually be used in practice.

By the end of this phase, **24 prompts had been developed further**.



THE GUIDE

The guide grows out of this work.

It is **meant for teachers and educators who need practical help**:

- how to write a clearer prompt,
- how to adapt a text,
- how to build activities more carefully around learner needs,
- and how to use ChatGPT without losing sight of context, judgement, and accessibility.
